Depaul - Fundraising Disclosure Statement

Depaul supports people who are homeless or at risk of homelessness.

Depaul operates as one charity but is registered as two separate legal entities in the Republic of Ireland (ROI) and Northern Ireland (NI). We have registered charity status in both jurisdictions.

Depaul shares close links with other members of the Vincentian Family and the Saint Vincent de Paul Society but we are a separate charity.

Depaul Disclosure Principles

In line with the Code of Fundraising Practice and the Guidelines for Charitable Organisations on Fundraising from the Public, Depaul believes donors have the right to be informed of the status and authority of those soliciting donations;

Depaul commits to being open about whether those seeking donations on behalf of the organisation are volunteers, employees of the organisation or are third party agents.

Anyone fundraising on behalf of Depaul must ensure that they clearly state to prospective donors that Depaul will benefit from their donations and those prospective donors are aware of their status, i.e. volunteers, employees or third party agents.

In line with data protection legislation, if an employee, Depaul does not expect the fundraiser to have to disclose personal details relating to their employment only details of where they work and who they are employed by.

Depaul is committed to ensuring that all our communications and dealings with the general public and our supporters are of the highest possible standard.

In any type of fundraising activity Depaul commits that fundraisers will at all times disclose the nature of their fundraising and that it will benefit Depaul.

For all donations made to Depaul where it is not an anonymous donation, Depaul will contact the donor whether in writing, by telephone or email to acknowledge their donation in all circumstances.
