If you've ever wondered how your gifts change lives, meet Barry... After years of addiction problems, sleeping rough, and many failed attempts to get his life back, this is how Barry's long and winding road 'home' ended with you —

“It's a lonely life,” Barry speaks so softly that at times it's difficult to hear him as he describes his lost and lonely years on the street. “I still find it hard to accept I got myself into that situation,” he tells us, sorrow filling his gentle grey eyes.

When coronavirus came knocking, we asked for your help to shield the most vulnerable people in our society from coronavirus. Your generosity saved countless lives.

But it was something else that marked a turning point for Barry and many others — a warm bed. Clean clothes. And being treated with respect and understanding — it's these treasured gifts you give that restore human dignity and long-lost hope.

Your belief in Barry gave him the courage to keep going... even when he could see no light at the end of the tunnel. And now your steadfast support has led Barry here — to the first home he's known for the past two decades.

"He had no confidence left"

If you met Barry today, you'd understand why Helen, his Depaul key worker, has a soft spot for him. "He's ever such a gentle soul," says Helen. "He had no confidence left when he arrived here as the first lockdown began."

Barry was so overcome when he saw the small room he'd be living in during lockdown, that he broke down in tears. "He couldn't believe it was for him," says Helen.

It was then Barry that decided this was his chance to make a change. After struggling for years with alcohol dependency, his first goal was to stop drinking.

"Helen and Depaul really helped me with my drinking," says Barry. "I had some difficult times, but I've cut it out, and I feel so much better for it."

"What we've found with the necessity of cocooning people, is that changing someone's environment has a huge impact on a person's self-worth," explains

Helen. "We've seen amazing changes in people practically overnight. Barry blossomed when he was here, and he's doing so well in his new home."

When coronavirus broke out, it was your generosity that brought the most marginalised homeless people here to Depaul... to safety.

"These are the people who slipped through the cracks. We haven't been able to reach them before," says Helen. "But here, you've given them the stability and support they'd never had."
