Your Love Lights the Way Home

Until only weeks ago, John thought he'd never again wake up feeling safe and warm in a home of his own. It's hard for you to hold onto hope when you've been homeless for a decade and a half. But today, John is here with a grateful heart to tell you it's never too late for your kindness to make a difference...

ere you to find yourself homeless tomorrow, it wouldn't be long until you felt the hope start to drain from your heart... a little more with each passing day. That's how it was for John.

You'll remember him. We shared his story with you this Christmas just gone. He was the man who found himself wandering the streets of Dublin alone on Christmas day, warm tears streaming down his freezing face.

John had already been homeless for 13 long years on that lonely Christmas morning.

His time on the streets has taken its toll, and he looks grim-faced as he recalls his daily struggle to survive, "You have to carry everything you own with you. You're walking around all day, sleeping in doorways and bus shelters. It grinds you down."

It would be another two years before John finally found his way to Depaul and into the warmth of your kindness.

Before Tom Fell Too Far

Because of caring hearts like you, Depaul can catch young people like Tom before they fall too deep into the cracks of our society. Before they become resigned to a lonely life with no home... no hope.

ike so many homeless young people who make their way here, Tom spent many years in the care system. His mam died when he was 14, and he's been carrying his grief with him ever since.

When he was forced to leave his foster home, he stayed with friends for as long as he could. But soon, he found himself with nowhere to go. And he had nobody in his life he could turn to.

A dawning hope

That's when Tom heard about Depaul's specialist youth homeless services powered by caring, understanding people like you who believe that everyone deserves a safe place they can call home.

At Peter's Place, the hope that once felt so far away for young people like Tom is reborn thanks to your compassion and concern.

With your help, each young person here gets a dedicated key worker to walk them through the complex housing application process, and help with finding a job, course, or apprenticeship.

"I just want to look after myself"

Thanks to your consideration for others, Tom has just moved into his new home and started a new job. He feels a sense of purpose he's never felt before. "Having a home and a job makes such a difference," he says. "I have something to do, a reason to get up in the morning. I want to be






